

WORLD TB DAY CAMPAIGN

Tuesday, March 24th 2020



World TB Day, falling on **March 24th** each year, is designed to build public awareness that tuberculosis today remains an epidemic in much of the world, causing the deaths of nearly 15 lakh people each year, mostly in developing countries.

It commemorates the day in 1882 when Dr. Robert Koch astounded the scientific community by announcing that he had discovered the cause of tuberculosis, the TB bacillus. At the time of Koch's announcement in Berlin, TB was causing the death of one out of every seven people.

Koch's discovery opened the way towards diagnosing and curing TB.

Under the theme 'It's Time', the spotlight this year is on urgently accelerating the TB response to save lives and end suffering.
